5 STATEMENT OF INTENT

6 This measure clarifies the definition of militia.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

- That the following proposed new section to article XI and amendment of section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the primary election to be held in 2004, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.
- SECTION 1. A new section to article XI of the Constitution of North Dakota is created and enacted as follows:
- The militia of this state consists of the active militia and the reserve militia.
- 16 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of North
 17 Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **Section 16.** The <u>reserve</u> militia of this state shall consist <u>consists</u> of all able-bodied
- 19 male persons individuals residing in the state, between the ages of eighteen and forty-five
- 20 years and individuals who volunteer and are accepted, except such as may be individuals
- 21 exempted by the laws of the United States or of this state. Persons Individuals whose religious
- 22 tenets or conscientious scruples forbid them to bear arms shall may not be compelled to do so
- 23 in times of peace, but shall pay an equivalent for a personal service.
- 24 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by the voters, this measure becomes 25 effective on August 1, 2004.
