4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 37-02-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- a. The adjutant general who is the chief of staff and must hold the rank of brigadier general. However, if an officer having a total of twenty years or more commissioned service in the armed forces, the adjutant general must hold the rank of major general holds a rank consistent with that individual's length of service and federal laws and regulations, but not to exceed the rank of lieutenant general.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-03-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 37-03-01. Adjutant general Appointment Qualifications Term Salary Office
 at Capital Removal. The adjutant general must be appointed by the governor, and shall
 appoint the adjutant general. Each candidate for the office must have been a federally
 recognized commissioned officer of the national guard for a period of at least three years
- 19 immediately preceding his the appointment. His , must have obtained the rank of lieutenant
- 20 <u>colonel or higher, and must have completed the educational requirements for appointment as a</u>
- 21 <u>federally recognized general officer. The</u> term of office is for six years and commences on
- 22 July 1, 1941 2001, and on every sixth anniversary thereof. Any vacancy in such office may be

- 3 commissions, retirement, and discharge apply to the adjutant general.
