1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 64-02-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to fees for testing and calibrating weighing and measuring devices.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 64-02-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **64-02-10. Fees to test or calibrate weighing and measuring devices.** The
7 commission shall collect the following fees to:

19		When a rejected weighing or measuring device has been reconditioned or replaced by	
20		new equipment, it must be retested and certified before being put into use except as otherwise	
21		provided by rule. The fee for retest and certification is the same as for the first test and	
22		certification.	
23		When a test of a weighing or measuring device is required in addition to the regularly	
24		scheduled annual test, the commission shall charge a fee equal to the cost of operating the	
25		motor vehicle used in conducting the test. The mileage charges, as determined by the	
26		commission, must be in addition to the regular test fee and calculated to cover the costs of the	
27		additional travel. Where a test has been requested and the person requesting it fails to appear	
28		or to have the weighing or measuring device ready for testing at the arranged time, there is a	
29		charge of ten dollars a quarter hour for the time between the arranged time and the time at	
30		which the test can begin.
