- 8. Credentials for teachers of title I;
- 17 9. Credentials for teachers of students who are mentally retarded;
- 18 10. Credentials for teachers of students who are physically disabled:
- 19 11. Credentials for coordinators of programs for students with limited English20 proficiency;
- 21 12. Credentials for school counselors;
- 22 13. Credentials for special education directors;
- 23 14. Credentials for special education strategists;
- 24 15. Credentials for teachers of students who have specific learning disabilities;
