1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact three new subsections to section 39-01-01 and a new

2 subsection to section 39-12-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to definitions of

3 motor vehicles and the width of motor vehicles; and to amend and reenact subsections 25 and

4 84 of section 39-01-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definitions of house

5 car and travel trailer.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7	SECTION 1. Three new subsections to section 39-01-01 of the North Dakota Century		
8	Code are created and enacted as follows:		
9	"Camping trailer" means a vehicular portable unit mounted on wheels and		
10	constructed with collapsible partial side walls that fold for towing by another vehicle		

and unfold at the campsite to provide temporary living quarters for recreational,
camping, or travel use.

- 13 "Fifth-wheel travel trailer" means a vehicular unit mounted on wheels, designed to
- 14 provide temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use, of such
- 15 size or weight as not to require a special highway movement permit and designed
- 16 to be towed by a motorized vehicle that contains a towing mechanism that is
- 17 mounted above or forward of the tow vehicle's rear axle.
- 18 "Truck camper" means a portable unit that is constructed to provide temporary
- 19 living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use; consists of a roof, floor, and
- 20 sides; and is designed to be loaded onto and unloaded from the bed of a pickup
- 21 <u>truck.</u>

21		or weight as not to require a special highway movement permit when towed by a

23	SECTION 3. A new subsection to section 39-12-04 of the North Dakota Century Code				
24	is created and enacted as follows:				
25	Motor homes, house cars, travel trailers, fifth-wheel travel trailers, camping trailers,				
26	and truck campers may exceed eight feet six inches [2.59 meters] in width if the				
27	excess is attributable to an appurtenance that extends beyond the body of the				
28		vehicl	e no more than six inches [15.24 centimeters] on either side of the vehicle.		
29		<u>For pι</u>	urposes of this subsection, the term appurtenance includes a shade awning		
30		and its	s support hardware, and any appendage that is intended to be an integral
