- 9 is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general
- 10 election to be held in 2002, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 11 North Dakota.

- 12 **SECTION 1.** A new section to article I of the Constitution of North Dakota is created
- 13 and enacted as follows:
- The right of individual privacy is essential to the well-being of a free society and may not
- 15 be infringed without the showing of a compelling state interest.
