- 1 A BILL for an Act for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4-34 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the receipt and use of assessments by the
- 3 ranchers-cattlemen's legal action fund, united stockgrowers of America; to amend and reenact
- 4 section 4-34-01, subsection 1 of section 4-34-08, and section 4-34-11 of the North Dakota
- 5 Century Code, relating to assessments on the sale of cattle; and to provide an effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-34-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 **4-34-01. Purposes.** The purposes of this chapter are:
 - To provide and participate in programs to increase the consumption of domestic beef through such means as advertising, research, consumer information, industry information, sales promotion, and education, but at no time may false or unwarranted claims be made on behalf of the beef industry.
 - To support beef promotion, research, and education activities of the national beef promotion and marketing organizations.
 - To initiate, encourage, and sponsor research designed to solve problems in the beef industry.
 - 4. To enhance the sale and production of North Dakota beef cattle.
- 19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 4-34-08 of the North Dakota 20 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 1. There is levied on each resident of this state selling cattle within the state or from
 the state, an assessment of fifty cents one dollar per head for each animal sold, or
 the amount assessed pursuant to the federal Beef Promotion and Research Act of
 1985 [7 U.S.C. 2901 et seq.] and applicable regulations, whichever is greater. The

1	moneys collected pursuant to this chapter must be paid to the commission
2	pursuant to this chapter and must be expended by the commission only as
3	authorized by this chapter.
4	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 4-34-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5	amended and reenacted as follows:
6	4-34-11. Refund of assessments. Any person who has made payment of
7	assessments under this chapter or who has had payment of assessments made on that
8	person's behalf may request and receive a refund, unless prohibited by federal law, and
9	provided that a written request and application for the refund is made within sixty days from the
10	date the assessments were due. Applications for refunds must be made by the seller
11	personally in such form as is reasonably required by the commission, and shall provide the
12	commission with sufficient information to identify assessments.
13	SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 4-34 of the North Dakota Century Code is
14	created and enacted as follows:
15	Ranchers-cattlemen's legal action fund, united stockgrowers of America - Receipt
16	and use of assessments. The commission shall forward twenty-five percent of any
17	assessments remaining after payment of all refunds, permitted under section 4-34-11 to the
18	ranchers- cattlemen's legal action fund, united stockgrowers of America. Representatives of
19	the ranchers-cattlemen's legal action fund, united stockgrowers of America may use the
20	assessments received under this section only for the purposes of providing market
21	maintenance and development services and supporting trade issues.
22	SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on the date the North
23	Dakota beef commission certifies to the secretary of state that the United States supreme court
24	has declared the federal Beef Promotion and Research Act of 1985 [7 U.S. C. 2901 et seq.] to
25	be unconstitutional.
