4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 39-29-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 1. "All-terrain vehicle" means any motorized off-highway vehicle fifty inches [1270.00 millimeters] or less in width, having a dry weight of ene two thousand pounds [453.59 907.18 kilograms] or less, traveling on three or more low-pressure tires, designed for operator use only with no passengers, having a seat or saddle designed to be straddled by the operator, and handlebars for steering control and having the ability to attain a speed in excess of twenty-five miles [40 kilometers] per hour.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 57-40.3-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 1. "All-terrain vehicle" means any motorized off-highway vehicle fifty inches [1270 millimeters] or less in width, having a dry weight of ene two thousand pounds [453.59 907.18 kilograms] or less, traveling on three or more low-pressure tires, designed for operator use only with no passengers, having a seat or saddle designed to be straddled by the operator, and handlebars for steering control and having the ability to attain a speed in excess of twenty-five miles [40 kilometers] per hour.
