1 A BILL for an Act to create a midwife registry.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 3 **SECTION 1. Midwife registry Fees.**
 - 1. The state department of health shall administer a midwife registry. The department may charge an annual registration fee of not more than one hundred dollars. The health council shall adopt rules necessary to administer this registry.
 - 2. An applicant is eligible for registration under this section if, on the effective date of this Act, the applicant holds in good standing a current license or other authorization by another state to practice as a traditional midwife. In order to renew a registration under this section, an individual shall verify to the department that this license or other authorization by the other state remains valid. The state health council may adopt rules to determine the registration eligibility of an applicant who does not otherwise meet the qualification for registration under this subsection.
 - 3. An individual who is registered under this section who is practicing within the scope of practice for a traditional midwife is exempt from the licensure requirements of all other health-related professions, including the practice of medicine and the practice of nursing.
