1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to creation of the beginning again North Dakota program by which the

3 department of commerce develops a data base of skills and other assets of North Dakota

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is

## Beginning again North Dakota program - Continuing appropriation.

The department shall implement and administer a beginning again North Dakota
 program. The purpose of the program is to develop a data base of skills and other
 assets of communities and residents to be used to advance the internal and
 external attitude and image of this state and the communities in this state.

- 13 2. The department shall assemble state and local asset data from a broad range of 14 sources. The sources for data may include the department, Bank of North Dakota, 15 game and fish department, state historical society, Indian affairs commission, job 16 service North Dakota, parks and recreation department, department of public 17 instruction, university system, workforce safety and insurance, and state and local 18 public or private entities. The nature of the data regarding skills and other assets 19 may cover a broad range of information that may be valuable to advance the 20 attitude or image of the state and communities in the state. The data may include 21 natural resources, real estate, educational resources, cultural resources, vocational 22 resources, financial resources, and infrastructure resources.
- 3. The department shall use the information assembled in the data base to assist in
  statewide and regional strategic plans for development. Additionally, the

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1	department may use the information in the data base to assist local developers in
2	strategic plans for development.
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4. The department may contract with a public or private third party to provide any or
all of the services necessary to implement and administer the program. The
department may solicit support and contributions from public and private sources
for the purpose of furthering the program. The department shall deposit in a
special account in the general fund of the state treasury all funds collected under
this subsection. All funds deposited under this section are appropriated to the
department on a continuing basis for the purpose of furthering the program.
