- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-52.5 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to employee criminal history record investigation.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-52.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Employee criminal history record investigation Fingerprinting required. The executive director of the retirement and investment office shall secure a complete set of fingerprints of any employee of the office who has unescorted physical access to the office or any security-sensitive area of the office as designated by the executive director. The executive director shall ensure that the fingerprints are submitted to the bureau of criminal investigation for verification of the identity of the employee and to obtain criminal history record information and to the federal bureau of investigation for a nationwide background check. The bureau of criminal investigation should provide any criminal history record information that may lawfully be made available under chapter 12-60 and the response of the federal bureau of investigation to the retirement and investment office.
