BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Wind easement - Definition. For purposes of sections 2 and 3 of this Act, the term wind easement means a right, whether stated in the form of a restriction, easement, covenant, or condition, in a deed, will, or other instrument executed by or on behalf of an owner of land or airspace for the purpose of insuring adequate exposure of a wind power system to the winds.

SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Creating and granting wind easements - Filing written agreement - Maximum term

- Development of energy potential required. A property owner may grant a wind easement
in the same matter and with the same effect as the conveyance of an interest in real property.

19 **SECTION 3.** A new section to chapter 47-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

Severance of wind energy rights limited. Except for a wind easement created under section 2 of this Act, an interest in a resource located on a tract of land and associated with the production or potential production of energy for wind power on the tract of land may not be severed from the surface estate.

- 1 **SECTION 4.** A new section to chapter 47-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 2 created and enacted as follows:
- Wind energy leases Termination. A lease for wind energy purposes is void and
- 4 terminates if development of the potential to produce energy from wind power has not occurred
- 5 on the lease hold within five years after the lease commences.
