A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 49-02 of the North Dakota
Century Code, relating to a renewable energy credit trading and tracking system by the public

3 service commission.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 49-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 created and enacted as follows:

7 Renewable energy credit trading and tracking system. Notwithstanding any other 8 provision of law, the commission, by rule or order, may establish a program for tradeable credits for electricity generated by an eligible energy technology. In establishing this program, the 9 10 commission shall implement a system that constrains or limits the cost of credits, taking care to 11 ensure that the system does not undermine the market for those credits. The commission may 12 facilitate the trading of renewable energy credits between states. This section applies to all 13 public utilities, including electric cooperatives and municipal electric utilities. As used in this 14 section, eligible energy technology includes solar; wind; hydroelectric with a capacity of less 15 than sixty megawatts; hydrogen, provided that after January 1, 2010, the hydrogen must be 16 generated from the resources listed in this section; or biomass, which includes an energy 17 recovery facility used to capture the heat value of mixed municipal solid waste or refuse-derived fuel from mixed municipal solid waste as a primary fuel. 18
