- 3 to hunting by nonresidents; and to amend and reenact sections 20.1-03-07 and 20.1-03-07.1 of
- 4 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to hunting by nonresidents and nonresident water fowl

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:
 - **20.1-03-07.** Licenses to hunt, trap, or fish required of nonresidents. Nonresidents, except as provided in sections 20.1-02-05, 20.1-03-07.3, and 20.1-03-08, and section 3 of this Act, may not:
 - 1. Hunt, catch, take, or kill any small game without a nonresident small game license. The nonresident small game license entitles the nonresident to hunt small game for any period of ten consecutive days or any two periods of five consecutive days each. The hunting period for which the license is valid must be designated on the license. A nonresident small game license is not required to hunt waterfowl under section 20.1-03-07.1. A nonresident may purchase more than one nonresident small game license per year.
 - 2. Trap, catch, attempt to catch, take, or kill any protected fur-bearing animal, except that nonresidents holding a valid nonresident fur-bearer and nongame hunting license may hunt only fox and coyote and except that residents of a state that allows North Dakota residents to trap within that state may purchase a nonresident reciprocal trapping license to trap in this state. However, a nonresident holding a

- 1 valid nonresident reciprocal trapping license may not trap, catch, attempt to catch, 2 take, or kill bobcats. 3 3. Catch, attempt to catch, take, or kill any fish without having a nonresident fishing 4 license. 5 4. Hunt, catch, take, or kill any unprotected bird or animal without having a 6 nonresident nongame hunting license or nonresident fur-bearer and nongame 7 hunting license. 8 5. Hunt, catch, take, or kill any big game animal without having the respective 9 nonresident big game license. 10 Each violation of this section is a distinct and separate offense. 11 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-07.1 of the North Dakota Century Code 12 is amended and reenacted as follows: 13 20.1-03-07.1. (Effective through December 31, 2007) Nonresident waterfowl 14 hunting license required. Except as provided in sections 20.1-02-05, 20.1-03-07.2, and 15 20.1-03-07.3, and section 3 of this Act, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that 16 individual first obtains a nonresident waterfowl hunting license. The nonresident waterfowl 17 hunting license entitles the nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any period of fourteen consecutive 18 days or any two periods of seven consecutive days each. A license authorizing the 19 fourteen-day hunting period allows hunting in a specified waterfowl hunting zone. A license 20 authorizing two 7-day hunting periods allows hunting in a specified zone during each period. 21 The governor, in the governor's proclamation, shall specify various waterfowl hunting zones for 22 which nonresident waterfowl hunting licenses will be available, and may specify the number of 23 licenses which may be issued in each zone and the manner in which they are to be issued. A 24 nonresident is entitled to purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year. 25 The fourteen-day, seven-day, and two 7-day hunting period restrictions do not apply to 26 nonresidents hunting in Richland and Sargent Counties during the early September Canada 27 goose season. 28 (Effective after December 31, 2007) Nonresident waterfowl hunting license 29
 - (Effective after December 31, 2007) Nonresident waterfowl hunting license required. Except as provided in sections 20.1-02-05, 20.1-03-07.2, and 20.1-03-07.3, and section 3 of this Act, a nonresident may not hunt waterfowl unless that individual first obtains a nonresident waterfowl hunting license. The nonresident waterfowl hunting license entitles the

1	nonresident to hunt waterfowl for any period of fourteen consecutive days or any two periods of
2	seven consecutive days each. A license authorizing the fourteen-day hunting period allows
3	hunting in a specified waterfowl hunting zone. A license authorizing two 7-day hunting periods
4	allows hunting in a specified zone during each period. The governor, in the governor's
5	proclamation, shall specify various waterfowl hunting zones for which nonresident waterfowl
6	hunting licenses will be available, and may specify the number of licenses which may be issued
7	in each zone and the manner in which they are to be issued. A nonresident is entitled to
8	purchase only one nonresident waterfowl hunting license per year.
9	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
10	created and enacted as follows:
11	Hunting by certain nonresidents. Upon payment of the fee required by section
12	20.1-03-12, a nonresident who was born in this state and completed five consecutive years of
13	elementary school in this state and a nonresident, not born in this state, but who graduated
14	from high school and completed at least five consecutive years of elementary and secondary
15	school in this state is eligible to purchase a lifetime nonresident hunting and fishing license.
16	The nonresident must provide the director such information as the director requires to establish
17	eligibility for a lifetime nonresident hunting and fishing license under this section and must
18	comply with the hunter education requirements of section 20.1-03-01.2. To maintain eligibility
19	for a nonresident lifetime hunting and fishing license, a nonresident must purchase an annual
20	general game license. Failure to purchase the annual general game license results in
21	automatic forfeiture of the nonresident lifetime hunting and fishing license.
22	SECTION 4. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code
23	is created and enacted as follows:
24	For a nonresident lifetime hunting and fishing license, five hundred dollars.
25	SECTION 5. A new section to chapter 20.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
26	created and enacted as follows:
27	Governors proclamation - Concern - The hunting of whitetailed deer. By
28	Proclamation, the governor my make a available to individuals possessing a nonresident
29	lifetime hunting and fishing license a licence to hunt whitetailed deer in the manner, places, and
30	times as the governor prescribes.
