6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-08 of the
7 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

8	d.	In the	case of benefits provided for outpatient treatment, the benefits must be
9		provid	led for a minimum of twenty visits for services covered under this section
10		in any	calendar year, provided the diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment
11		servic	es are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed physician, a
12		licens	ed psychologist who is eligible for listing on the national register of
13		health	n service providers in psychology, or the treatment services are provided
14		within	the scope of licensure by a licensed addiction counselor. The
15		insura	ance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health
16		maint	enance organization may not establish a deductible or a copayment for
17		the fir	st five visits in any calendar year, and may not establish a copayment
18		greate	er than twenty percent for the remaining visits.
19	SECTION	N 2. A	MENDMENT. Paragraph 4 of subdivision f of subsection 2 of section
20	26.1-36-09 of the	e North	Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
21		(4)	The insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health
22			maintenance organization may not establish a deductible or a
23			copayment for the first five hours in any calendar year, and may not
