- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-08 and
- 2 paragraph 4 of subdivision f of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-09 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to group health policy and health service contract substance abuse and mental
- 4 disorder insurance coverage.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- d. In the case of benefits provided for outpatient treatment, the benefits must be provided for a minimum of twenty visits for services covered under this section in any calendar year, provided the diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed physician, a licensed psychologist who is eligible for listing on the national register of health service providers in psychology, or the treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed addiction counselor. The insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization may not establish a deductible or a copayment for the first five visits in any calendar year, and may not establish a copayment greater than twenty percent for the remaining treatment visits.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Paragraph 4 of subdivision f of subsection 2 of section 20 26.1-36-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - (4) The insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization may not establish a deductible or a copayment for the first five hours in any calendar year, and may not
