1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study methods for the construction 2 of highways in this state. 3 **WHEREAS**, the highways in this state are necessary for the industries of agriculture and tourism; and 4 5 WHEREAS, this state spends major sums of money on the construction and repair of 6 highways; and 7 WHEREAS, other states and countries have investigated different methods of highway 8 construction and the cost effectiveness of certain construction methods over time; and 9 WHEREAS, the model used for the interstate system, is considered to be a state of the 10 art highway; 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 12 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 13 That the legislative council study the methods for the construction of highways in this 14 state; and 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the legislative council report its findings and 16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 17 the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
