- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-39.2-04 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to a sales and use tax exemption for nonprescription drugs and
- 3 health products; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 57-39.2-04 of the North Dakota Century 6 Code is created and enacted as follows: 7 Gross receipts from sales of over-the-counter drugs for human use or 8 consumption. For purposes of this section, "over-the-counter drugs" must be 9 prepackaged with Drug Facts panel or statement of the active ingredients with a 10 list of those ingredients contained in the compound, substance, or preparation, and includes: 11 12 Allergy relief products, asthma medications, and sinus medications. a. 13 b. Cold medications, cough drops and lozenges, cough syrups, nasal 14 decongestants, sore throat remedies, and topical vapor products. 15 Antacids and antigas products, antidiarrheal preparations, antinausea C. 16 preparations, and laxatives. 17 d. Feminine deodorants and itching remedies, feminine yeast infection 18 remedies, and feminine personal lubricants. 19 Arthritis pain relievers, general pain relievers, and menstrual relief products. e. 20 f. Herbal products, vitamins, and minerals sold as nutritional supplements. 21 Acne aids; anti-itch products; corn, callus, and wart removers; diaper rash g. 22 products; eye care products; first-aid products; fungicidal preparations; hair 23 regrowth treatments; hemorrhoidal preparations; oral care products; and 24 topical analgesics.
