- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 43-10-22.2 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to funeral establishment ownership disclosures.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** Section 43-10-22.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
 - 43-10-22.2. Disclosure of ownership Change in ownership.
 - A funeral establishment shall include in all of the funeral establishment's business literature, correspondence, advertising, price lists, and contracts a statement as to who owns the controlling interest in the funeral establishment.
 - 2. Within fifteen days of a change in ownership of a funeral establishment, the funeral establishment shall notify each pre-need consumer by first-class mail of the change in ownership. The notification must inform each pre-need consumer of the consumer's right to transfer all pre-need deposited funds to a new establishment and must inform each pre-need consumer who has revocable pre-need deposited funds of the consumer's right to terminate the deposit and receive a refund of all principal paid and interest accrued.
 - 3. For purposes of this section:
 - a. "Change in ownership" means the sale or transfer of all or substantially all of the assets of a funeral establishment, the sale or transfer of a controlling interest of a funeral establishment, or the termination of the business of a funeral establishment in which there is no transfer of assets or stock.
 - b. "Controlling interest" means an interest in a partnership of greater than fifty percent; a membership interest in a limited liability company of greater than

- 1 fifty percent; or greater than fifty percent shareholder of the issued and
- 2 outstanding shares of a stock of a corporation.
