- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-39.1 and a new subsection to
- 2 section 15-39.1-24 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to participation by short-term
- 3 summer school contract teachers in the teachers' fund for retirement; to provide an effective
- 4 date; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-39.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

8 Short-term summer school contract teachers - Participation not required -

- 9 **Election.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a teacher who is not covered under a
- 10 public school teaching contract during the regular school year and who teaches a summer
- 11 school course or summer school program on a short-term contract basis may elect not to
- 12 participate in the fund for the period of the short-term contract. To elect not to participate in the
- 13 fund under this section, a teacher must notify the governmental entity by which the teacher is
- 14 employed in writing within thirty days of entering the contract or before the first payment is
- 15 received by the teacher, whichever occurs earlier. If a teacher fails to make an election under
- 16 this section, the teacher is a member of the fund. If a teacher elects not to participate in the
- 17 fund under this section, the teacher and the governmental entity by which the teacher is
- 18 employed are not required to make contributions to the fund for the period of the short-term
- 19 summer school contract.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 15-39.1-24 of the North Dakota Century
- 21 Code is created and enacted as follows:
- A teacher may purchase service credit at the actuarial equivalent cost for the time
- 23 spent teaching under a short-term summer school contract.
- **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on June 1, 2005.

1 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
