5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 12.1-23-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 12.1-23-11. Unauthorized use of personal identifying information Penalty.
- As used in this section, "personal identifying information" means any of the
 following information:
- 10 a. An individual's name;
- 11 b. An individual's address;
- 12 c. An individual's telephone number;
- 13 d. The distinguishing operator's license number assigned to an individual by the
 14 department of transportation under section 39-04-14;
- 15 e. An individual's social security number;
- 16 f. An individual's employer or place of employment;
- g. An identification number assigned to the individual by the individual's
 employer;
- 19 h. The maiden name of the individual's mother; or
- 20 i. The identifying number of a depository account in a financial institution.
- A person is guilty of a class C felony if the person uses or attempts to use any
 personal identifying information of an individual, living or deceased, to obtain
- 23 credit, money, goods, services, or anything else of value without the authorization
