A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-27-37 of the North Dakota Century Code, 1

2 relating to reimbursement claims for teacher compensation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-27-37 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6	15.1	-27-3	37. Compensation of teachers - Claim for reimbursement - Rules.
7	1.	On	or before October first of each year or within thirty days after the conclusion of
8		the	negotiation process provided for in chapter 15.1-16, the board of a school
9		distr	ict may file a claim with the superintendent of public instruction for the
10		reim	bursement of moneys to be expended by the district during the school year to
11		at le	east maintain or increase the level of compensation provided to teachers
12		emp	ployed by the district during the 2002-03 preceding school year.
13	2.	The	claim must include:
14		a.	The number of full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of
15			September fifteenth;
16		b.	The number of full-time equivalent teachers whose level of compensation will
17			be at least equal to that provided during the 2002-03 preceding school year;
18			and
19		C.	The total amount of any compensation increases provided to full-time
20			equivalent teachers over the level of compensation provided during the
21			2002-03 preceding school year.
22	3.	a.	For the 2003-04 school year, the The reimbursement provided for in this

section may not exceed three thousand dollars multiplied by the number of

1		full-time equivalent teachers employed by the district as of September 15,
2		2003.
3		b. For the 2004-05 school year, the reimbursement provided for in this section
4		may not exceed three thousand dollars multiplied by the number of full-time
5		equivalent teachers employed by the district as of September 15, 2004.
6		c. For the 2003-04 school year, the reimbursement under this section for each
7		individual employed as of September 15, 2003, as a full time equivalent
8		teacher for the first school year since becoming licensed to teach by the
9		education standards and practices board or approved to teach by the
10		education standards and practices board, may not exceed one thousand
11		dollars.
12		d. For the 2004-05 school year, the reimbursement under this section for each
13		individual employed as of September 15, 2004, as a full-time equivalent
14		teacher for the first school year since becoming licensed to teach by the
15		education standards and practices board or approved to teach by the
16		education standards and practices board, may not exceed one thousand
17		dollars <u>fifteenth</u> .
18	4.	For purposes of this section, the claim of a district may include proportionate
19		expenditures made by the district to compensate individuals employed as teachers
20		by the special education unit or the area career and technology center to which the
21		district belongs.
22	5.	The superintendent of public instruction may adopt rules regarding claims for and
23		the payment of reimbursements under this section.
