1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 24-02-01.5, 39-24-01, and 39-24-04 of the

2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to collector snowmobiles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 24-02-01.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is 5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 24-02-01.5. (Contingent effective date - See note - Effective through June 30,

7 2005) Department of transportation - Administrative rules. The department of

8 transportation may adopt the administrative rules necessary to carry out its responsibilities and

9 functions as created and transferred by sections 24-02-01.1 through 24-02-01.5. Rules

10 adopted by the agencies whose functions relate to the functions or agencies created,

11 transferred, or covered by sections 2-05-03, 24-02-01.1 through 24-02-01.5, subsections 7 and

12 11 of section 24-01-01.1, sections 24-02-13, 24-16-02, 24-17-02, subsections 8, 12, and 13 of

13 section 39-01-01, subsection 1 of section 39-16-01, subsection 7 of section 39-24-01,

14 subsection 2 of section 49-17.1-01, subsection 1 of section 54-06-04, subsection 1 of section

15 54-27-19, subsection 6 of section 57-40.3-01, subsection 1 of section 57-43.1-01, section

16 57-43.1-44, subsection 6 of section 57-43.2-01, and section 57-43.2-37 remain in effect until

17 they are specifically amended or repealed by the department.

18 (Effective after June 30, 2005) Department of transportation - Administrative rules.

5		SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 39-24-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is						
6	amenc	amended and reenacted as follows:						
7		39-24-01. Definitions. For the purposes of this chapter:						
8		1. "Collector snowmobile" means a snowmobile that is twenty-five years old or older,						
9			was originally produced as a separate identifiable make by a manufacturer, and is					
10			owned and operated solely as a collector's item.					
11		<u>2.</u>	"Dealer" means every a person, partnership, corporation, or limited liability					
12			company engaged in the business of buying, selling, or exchanging snowmobiles,					
13			or who advertises , or holds out to the public as <u>being</u> engaged in the buying,					
14			selling, or exchanging of snowmobiles, or who engages in the buying of					
15			snowmobiles for resale.					
16	2.	<u>3.</u>	"Operate" means to ride in or on and control the operation of a snowmobile.					
17	3.	<u>4.</u>	"Operator" means every person who operates or is in actual physical control of a					
18			snowmobile.					
19	4.	<u>5.</u>	"Owner" means a person, other than a lienholder, having the property in or title to a					
20			snowmobile and who is entitled to the use or possession thereof of that					
21			snowmobile.					
22		5.	"Person" includes an individual, partnership, corporation, limited liability company,					
23			association, the state and its departments, agencies, and political subdivisions, and					
24			any body of persons, whether incorporated or not.					
25		6.	"Register" means the act of assigning a registration number to a snowmobile.					
26		7.	"Registrar" means the director of the department of transportation of this state as					
27			provided in section 24-02-01.3.					
28		8.	"Roadway" means that portion of a highway improved, designed, or ordinarily used					
29			for vehicular travel.					
30	9.	<u>8.</u>	"Snowmobile" means a self-propelled vehicle designed for travel on snow, ice, or a					
31			natural terrain and steered by skis or runners.

9		a.	Snowmobiles owned and used by the United States or another state or its						
10			political subdivisions.						
11		b.	Snowmobiles registered in a country other than the United States and						
12			temporarily used within this state.						
13		c.	Snowmobiles validly licensed in another state and which have not been within						
14			this state for more than thirty consecutive days.						
15		d.	Snowmobiles operated upon lands owned or leased by the snowmobile						
16			owner.						
17		e.	Snowmobiles incapable of speeds in excess of ten miles per hour and with an						
18			engine displacement of less than one hundred cubic centimeters.						
19		<u>f.</u>	Collector snowmobiles. The director may issue a special permit to a person						
20			to operate in a parade; in organized group outings, including races, rallies, or						
21			other promotional events; and for up to ten days each year for personal						
22			transportation. The permit must be in the form of a card to be carried on or by						
23			the operator of the collector snowmobile. The permit is valid for the duration						
24			of ownership of the snowmobile by the recipient of the permit. The director						
25			may impose a reasonable restriction of a permittee and may revoke, amend,						
26			suspend, or modify a permit for cause.

28	1.	A r	egistration number must be issued without the payment of a fee for						
29		sno	owmobiles owned by the state of North Dakota or any of its political subdivisions

31	2.	No	registration or fees may be required of:						

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1		a.	Snowmobiles owned and used by the United States or another state or its
2			political subdivisions.
3		b.	Snowmobiles registered in a country other than the United States and
4			temporarily used within this state.
5		C.	Snowmobiles validly licensed in another state and which have not been within
6			this state for more than thirty consecutive days.
7		d.	Snowmobiles operated upon lands owned or leased by the snowmobile
8			owner.
9		e.	Snowmobiles incapable of speeds in excess of ten miles per hour and with an
10			engine displacement of less than one hundred cubic centimeters.
11		<u>f.</u>	Collector snowmobiles. The director may issue a special permit to a person
12			to operate in a parade; organized group outings, including races, rallies, or
13			other promotional events; and for up to ten days each year for personal
14			transportation. The director may impose a reasonable restriction of a
15			permittee and may revoke, amend, suspend, or modify a permit for cause.
16	3.	lf a	snowmobile is exempt from registration under subdivision b or c of
17		sub	section 2, the owner is required to display on the snowmobile a decal received
18		upc	on payment of a fifteen dollar per year trail access fee. Fees collected under
19		this	subsection must be deposited in the state snowmobile fund.
