## SENATE BILL NO. 2238

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-33 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a credit against rural electric
- 3 cooperative gross receipts taxes and a credit against corporate income taxes for electricity
- 4 purchased from school districts that generate electricity using wind turbines; and to provide an
- 5 effective date.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 57-33 of the North Dakota Century Code iscreated and enacted as follows:
- 9 **Credit for purchase of electricity from school districts.** A cooperative is entitled to a 10 credit against taxes due under this chapter for a portion of the cost of electricity purchased by
- 11 the cooperative from a school district and generated by a wind turbine owned by the school
- 12 district. The amount of the credit is equal to the number of kilowatt hours of electricity
- 13 purchased, times the purchase price paid per kilowatt hour minus the avoided cost of electricity.
- 14 For purposes of this section:
  - "Avoided cost of electricity" means the cost per kilowatt hour for electricity
    produced by the cooperative or purchased by the cooperative in the open market,
    whichever is less.
    - 2. "Purchase price paid per kilowatt hour" means the price per kilowatt hour for electricity paid by the cooperative to the school district.
- SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
  - Credit for purchase of electricity from school districts. An investor-owned utility corporation is entitled to a credit against taxes due under section 57-38-30 for a portion of the cost of electricity purchased by the corporation from a school district and generated by a wind

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- 1 turbine owned by the school district. The amount of the credit is equal to the number of kilowatt
- 2 hours of electricity purchased, times the purchase price paid per kilowatt hour minus the
- 3 avoided cost of electricity. For purposes of this section:
- 1. "Avoided cost of electricity" means the cost per kilowatt hour for electricity
  produced by the corporation or purchased by the corporation in the open market,
  whichever is less.
  - "Purchase price paid per kilowatt hour" means the price per kilowatt hour for electricity paid by the corporation to the school district.
- 9 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act is effective for purchases of electricity occurring after June 30, 2005.
