## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 20.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Governor's proclamation concerning the hunting of deer - North Dakota quality deer management, incorporated, raffle and auction. By proclamation, the governor may make available to North Dakota quality deer management, incorporated, one antlered white-tailed or mule deer license per year to hunt deer in the manner, places, and times as the governor prescribes. North Dakota quality deer management, incorporated, shall hold a raffle or by proclamation the governor may auction to the highest bidder, whether resident or nonresident, a license to hunt antlered white-tailed or mule deer in the manner, places, and times the governor prescribes. If an individual receives a mule deer license through the raffle or the auction, the individual is not eligible to apply for a mule deer license through the game and fish department that year. No more than ten percent of the gross proceeds of the raffle may be used to promote the raffle and all net proceeds of the raffle and all proceeds of the auction must be used for hunter education for quality deer management, promotion of the quality deer management concept, establishment of quality deer management sites to collect deer demographic information, and to support and promote youth hunting programs and opportunities and related projects in North Dakota. North Dakota quality deer management, incorporated, shall submit reports concerning the raffle as the director requires.
