- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 9 of section 12.1-32-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to sentencing alternatives; and to repeal section 62.1-02-12 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the purchase of certain firearms from another state.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 9 of section 12.1-32-02 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 9. A person who is convicted of a felony and sentenced to imprisonment for not more than one year is deemed to have been convicted of a misdemeanor. However, if an order is entered revoking a probation imposed as a part of the sentence, the person is deemed to have been convicted of a felony. This subsection does not apply to a person convicted of violating subdivision a, b, or c of subsection 1 of section 19-03.1-23 or section 62.1-02-01.
- SECTION 2. REPEAL. Section 62.1-02-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
