- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 24 of section 57-39.2-04 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to a sales and use tax exemption for sales made to an
- 3 emergency medical services provider; and to provide an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 24 of section 57-39.2-04 of the North Dakota
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 24. Gross receipts from all sales when made to an eligible facility <u>or emergency</u>
- 8 <u>medical services provider</u> for the use or benefit of its patient or occupant. For the
- 9 purposes of this subsection, "eligible facility" means any hospital, skilled nursing
- 10 facility, intermediate care facility, or basic care facility licensed by the state
- 11 department of health and "emergency medical services provider" means an
- 12 emergency medical services operation licensed by the state department of health
- 13 <u>under chapter 23-27</u>.
- SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable events occurring after
 June 30, 2005.
