- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 32-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to immunity for altered liquified petroleum gas equipment or appliances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 32-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Immunity for altered liquified petroleum gas equipment or appliance.

- Any person engaged in the state in the business of selling at retail, supplying, handling, or transporting liquified petroleum gas is immune from civil liability for any loss, damage, or injury if the injury, damage, or loss was caused by:
 - a. The alteration, modification, or repair of liquified petroleum gas equipment or a liquified petroleum gas appliance if the alteration, modification, or repair was done without the knowledge and consent of the liquified petroleum gas seller, supplier, handler, or transporter; or
 - b. The use of liquified petroleum gas equipment or a liquified petroleum gas appliance in a manner or for a purpose other than that for which the equipment or appliance was intended and that reasonably could have been expected.
- 2. This section does not limit the jurisdiction of the public service commission under title 49 or 64.
