1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 39-16-03.1 of the North

2 Dakota Century Code, relating to driver record abstract; to amend and reenact section 5-01-08

3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to an underage person in a licensed premises with

4 alcoholic beverages; and to provide a penalty.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 5-01-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

5-01-08. Persons under twenty-one years of age prohibited from manufacturing,
 purchasing, consuming, or possessing using alcoholic beverages or entering licensed

10 premises - Penalty - Exceptions - Referrals to addiction facilities - Jurisdiction.

- <u>1.</u> Except as permitted in this section and section 5-02-06, a person under twenty-one
 years of age may not manufacture or attempt to manufacture, purchase or attempt
 to purchase, consume or have recently consumed other than during a religious
 service, be under the influence of, be in possession of, or furnish money to any
 person for the purchase of an alcoholic beverage, or.
- <u>A person under twenty-one years of age may not enter any licensed premises</u>
 where alcoholic beverages are being sold or displayed, except a:
- 18 <u>a.</u> <u>A</u> restaurant when <u>if</u> accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or in;
- 19 <u>b.</u> <u>In</u> accordance with section 5-02-06, or if;
- 20 <u>c.</u> <u>If</u> the person is a law enforcement officer or other public official who enters the 21 premises in the performance of official duty,; or if
- 22d.If the person enters the premises for training, education, or research purposes23under the supervision of a person twenty-one or more years of age with prior24notification of the local licensing authority.

1	<u>3.</u>	A violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor. Upon conviction for a
2		violation of subsection 2, the defendant shall surrender any license or permit to
3		operate a motor vehicle to the court. The court shall forward the license or permit
4		to the department with notification of the conviction. The department shall suspend
5		the permit or license for fifteen days.
6	<u>4.</u>	The court may, under this section, refer the person to an outpatient addiction
7		facility licensed by the state department of human services for evaluation and
8		appropriate counseling or treatment.
9	<u>5.</u>	The offense of consumption occurs in the county of consumption or the county
10		where the offender is arrested.
11	SEC	CTION 2. A new subsection to section 39-16-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code
12	is created and enacted as follows:
