- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to school reporting of student progress and achievement.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- State assessments Report to parents.
  - 1. Upon the release of state assessment results by the superintendent of public instruction, each school shall issue a report to the parents of each student. The superintendent of public instruction shall format the report to contain the student's individual test scores based on the state standards. The information must be presented in a fashion that allows the student's parents to easily compare the student's progress and achievement to that of others:
    - a. In the student's classroom;
  - b. At the same grade level in the student's school and school district;
- c. At the same grade level in contiguous school districts;
  - d. At the same grade level in the state; and
- e. At the same grade level of the most current national assessment of education progress.
- If a student's parents maintain joint custody of the student, the school may send a report to each of the student's parents.
