1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 23-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to health council membership inclusion of an enrolled member of a federally recognized

3 tribe and a representative of the food service industry.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 23-01-02. Health council - Members, terms of office, vacancies, compensation, 8 officers, meetings. The health council consists of eleven thirteen members appointed by the 9 governor in the following manner: four persons individuals from the health care field, five 10 persons individuals representing consumer interests, one individual who is a North Dakota 11 resident and who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe, one person individual 12 from the energy industry, one individual from the food service industry, and one individual from 13 the manufacturing and processing industry. The governor may select members to the council 14 from recommendations submitted by tribal governments and by trade, professional, and 15 consumer organizations. On the expiration of the term of any member, the governor, in the 16 manner provided by this section, shall appoint for a term of three years, persons individuals to 17 take the place of members whose terms on the council are about to expire. The officers of the 18 council must be elected annually. Any state agency may serve in an advisory capacity to the 19 health council at the discretion of the council. The council shall meet at least twice each year 20 and at other times as the council or its chairman may direct. The health council shall may have 21 as standing committees any committees the council may find necessary. The chairman of the 22 council shall select the members of these committees. The members of the council are entitled 23 to receive sixty-two dollars and fifty cents as compensation per day and their the member's 24 necessary mileage and travel expenses as provided in sections 44-08-04 and 54-06-09 while

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- 1 attending council meetings or in the performance of any special duties as the council may
- 2 direct. The per diem and expenses must be audited and paid in the manner in which the
- 3 expenses of state officers are audited and paid. The compensation provided for in this section
- 4 may not be paid to any member of the council who received salary or other compensation as a
- 5 regular employee of the state, or any of its the state's political subdivisions, or any institution or
- 6 industry operated by the state.
