1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 23-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the compensation of housing authority commissioners.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23-11-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **23-11-05. Commissioners of authority - Appointment, qualifications, tenure,**  
7 **compensation.** When the governing body of a city adopts a resolution, declaring there is need  
8 for a housing authority, ~~it~~ the governing body promptly shall notify the mayor of ~~such the~~  
9 adoption. Upon receiving ~~such the~~ notice, the mayor shall appoint five persons as  
10 commissioners of the authority ~~created for said city~~. When the governing body of a county  
11 adopts a resolution declaring there is need for a housing authority, ~~said the governing body~~  
12 shall appoint five persons as commissioners of the authority ~~created for said county~~. The  
13 commissioners who are first appointed must be designated to serve for terms of one, two,  
14 three, four, and five years, respectively, from the date of ~~their~~ appointment, and ~~thereafter, after~~  
15 that time each commissioner must be appointed for a term of office of five years except that all  
16 vacancies must be filled for the unexpired term. A commissioner shall hold office until a  
17 successor has been appointed and has qualified. A certificate of the appointment or  
18 reappointment of any commissioner must be filed with the auditor of the city or county, as the  
19 case may be, and ~~such the~~ certificate is conclusive evidence of the due and proper  
20 appointment of ~~such the~~ commissioner. A commissioner, other than one who is a county  
21 commissioner, may receive ~~ten dollars up to forty-five dollars~~ a day for each day necessarily  
22 devoted to the work of the office ~~and is entitled to the necessary expenses, including traveling~~  
23 ~~expenses, incurred in the discharge of those duties~~. The per diem compensation provided for  
24 in this section may not exceed ~~three~~ six hundred dollars in any one fiscal year. A
