- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-25.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to child abuse and neglect records and information; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 50-25.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to privileged
- 4 communications.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 50-25.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Access to records and information. Upon the request of the department or its
- 9 designee, in the course of an assessment for child abuse or neglect, any hospital, physician,
- 10 medical professional, medical facility, mental health professional, or mental health facility shall
- 11 disclose information and records of that entity regarding the child which are relevant to the
- 12 assessment. The person submitting the request shall reimburse the disclosing entity for the
- 13 <u>actual costs of assembling and providing the information.</u>
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-25.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 16 **50-25.1-10. Abrogation of privileged communications.** Any privilege of
- 17 communication between husband and wife or between any professional person and the
- 18 person's patient or client, except between attorney and client, is abrogated and does not
- 19 constitute grounds for preventing a report to be made or for excluding evidence in any
- 20 proceeding regarding child abuse, neglect, or death resulting from abuse or neglect resulting
- 21 from a report made under this chapter. Privilege of communication between any health care
- 22 professional and the professional's patient does not constitute grounds for refusing access to
- 23 information and records requested under section 1 of this Act.
