- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-25.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to child abuse and neglect records and information; and to amend and
- 3 reenact section 50-25.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to privileged
- 4 communications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 50-25.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Access to records and information. Upon the request of the department or its
- 9 designee, in the course of an assessment for child abuse or neglect, any hospital, physician,
- 10 medical professional, medical facility, mental health professional, or mental health facility shall
- 11 disclose information and records of that entity regarding the child which are relevant to the
- 12 assessment. The person submitting the request shall reimburse the disclosing entity for the
- 13 actual costs of assembling and providing the information.
- 14 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 50-25.1-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 16 **50-25.1-10. Abrogation of privileged communications.** Any privilege of
- 17 communication between husband and wife or between any professional person and the
- 18 person's patient or client, except between attorney and client, is abrogated and does not
- 19 constitute grounds for preventing:
- 20 <u>1.</u> Refusing access to any information or record requested for a child abuse or
- 21 neglect assessment or any other investigation or proceeding under this chapter;
- 22 <u>2. Preventing</u> a report to be made; or for excluding

- <u>Excluding</u> evidence in any proceeding <u>under this chapter</u> regarding child abuse,
 neglect, or death resulting from abuse or neglect resulting from a report made
- 3 under this chapter.
