- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study taxation of severed mineral 2 interests, including the laws in other states and problems associated with severed mineral 3 interests. 4 WHEREAS, orderly development of mineral resources in North Dakota is important to 5 the economy of the state; and 6 WHEREAS, landowners must absorb increased costs of updating abstracts if underlying 7 mineral interests have been severed from the surface estate; and 8 WHEREAS, for more that 20 years North Dakota has had statutory provisions for 9 termination of unused severed mineral interests and it is uncertain whether the laws are 10 accomplishing their intended purpose; and 11 WHEREAS, examination should be undertaken of the effectiveness of laws in other 12 states providing for transfer taxes on severed mineral interests and other methods to 13 discourage fractionalization of severed mineral interests; and 14 WHEREAS, fractionalized mineral interests impede and increase costs of mineral 15 leasing and development to the detriment of suface owners, mineral exploration and 16 development companies, mineral and royalty owners, and the public; 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 18 19 That the Legislative Council study taxation of severed mineral interests, including the
