SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4010

1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study alternatives to the current
2	method of expressing property tax levies in mills per dollar of taxable valuation.
3	WHEREAS, property taxes levied by the state and political subdivisions are expressed
4	in mills per dollar of taxable valuation of property; and
5	WHEREAS, converting mills per dollar of taxable valuation into actual property taxes
6	against market value of property is difficult and confusing; and
7	WHEREAS, converting property tax levies into an understandable measure, such as tax
8	dollars per one thousand dollars of market value, would allow citizens to understand property
9	tax levies and judge how property taxes will impact them;
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
11	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
12	That the Legislative Council study alternatives to the current method of expressing
13	property tax levies in mills per dollar of taxable valuation; and
14	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16	the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
