## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3008

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study agricultural commodity

2 organizations and the Legislative Assembly oversight of commodity appropriations and3 charges.

WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly establishes in statute the assessments or
"checkoff" rates for each agricultural commodity program and the funds received are
appropriated on a continuing basis to the respective agricultural commodity organization; and
WHEREAS, other Midwestern states have varying levels of control over the
assessments or "checkoff" rates charged and use of funds received by their state agricultural

9 commodity organizations; and

WHEREAS, audit findings have been issued for agricultural commodity organizations
incurring or committing to expenditures in excess of anticipated biennial revenues; and

12 **WHEREAS**, major actions or obligations incurred by the agricultural commodity

13 organizations are not approved by or reported in a timely manner to the Legislative Assembly;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

15 OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Legislative Council study North Dakota agricultural commodity organizations
and the Legislative Assembly control of appropriations and rates charged by the agricultural
commodity organizations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
recommendations together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
the Sixtieth Legislative Assembly.
