SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4021

1	A concurrent resolution urging Congress to allow for the travel of United States citizens to and
2	from Cuba and to allow direct banking transfers between the United States and Cuba for the
3	purchase of American-made products by Cuba.
4	WHEREAS, in 1962 the United States imposed economic sanctions on Cuba; and
5	WHEREAS, the Trade Sanctions Reform and Export Enhancement Act of 2000
6	reauthorized direct commercial cash-only sales of agricultural products, food, and medicine to
7	Cuba; and
8	WHEREAS, many of the primary commodities produced in the United States are valued
9	and sought after by the citizens of Cuba; and
10	WHEREAS, it is anticipated that sales of this state's agricultural products alone to Cuba
11	could surpass \$37.8 million annually and provide employment for more than 1,000 individuals;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, while some humanitarian and educational groups, journalists, and
14	diplomats are allowed to visit Cuba each year, many other American citizens are not, thereby
15	hindering efforts to expand trade with Cuba; and
16	WHEREAS, the United States prohibits direct banking transfers between this country
17	and Cuba for the purchase of American-made products by Cuba, thereby reducing the level of
18	product sales; and
19	WHEREAS, a recent ruling by the United States Department of the Treasury's Office of
20	Foreign Assets Control requiring payment for United States agricultural exports in advance of
21	shipment to Cuba threatens to jeopardize accords and terminate agricultural trade with Cuba;
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA,
23	THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly urges Congress to allow for the travel of
United States citizens to and from Cuba and to allow direct banking transfers between the
United States and Cuba for the purchase of American-made products by Cuba; and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
resolution to the President of the United States, the United States Secretary of State, the
United States Secretary of Agriculture, the majority and minority leaders of the United States
Senate and the United States House of Representatives, and to each member of the North
Dakota Congressional Delegation.
