1 A concurrent resolution urging the President of the United States to protect, defend, and

2 support federal antitrust and securities fraud laws.

WHEREAS, Waste Management, Inc., is a monopoly and is one of the top two holding
companies, the other being Burlington Northern, Inc., of the New York Stock Exchange; and

- 5 **WHEREAS**, Waste Management International was listed on the New York Stock
- 6 Exchange even though the company did not own any existing facility; and

7 WHEREAS, Waste Management, Inc., and Waste Management International were
8 listed on the New York Stock Exchange at the same time in breach of the Sherman antitrust

9 laws; and

10 WHEREAS, Waste Management International was removed from the New York Stock

11 Exchange without prosecution for violation of antitrust or securities fraud laws;

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 13 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Fifty-ninth Legislative Assembly urges the President of the United States to
take action to protect, defend, and support federal antitrust and securities fraud laws; and **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this
resolution to the President of the United States, the United States Securities and Exchange
Commission, the United States Department of Justice, and to each member of the North
Dakota Congressional Delegation.
