**SENATE BILL NO. 2069**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 54-10-02 and 54-10-22.1 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to the state auditor's access to records.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-10-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **54-10-02. Auditor to have access to all state offices.** The state auditor shall have  
7 access to all state offices during business hours for the purpose of inspecting ~~such~~ books,  
8 papers, ~~and~~ accounts, and records therein as may concern the state auditor's duties. Access  
9 includes inspection of any books, papers, accounts, or records that the state auditor may deem  
10 relevant to an ongoing audit of any other state agency or computer system audit.

11 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-10-22.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
12 amended and reenacted as follows:

13 **54-10-22.1. State auditor's access to information relating to operations of**  
14 **governmental entities subject to audit.** Notwithstanding any other specific sections of law,  
15 the state auditor and persons employed by the state auditor, when necessary in conducting an  
16 audit, shall have access to all information relating to operations of all governmental units  
17 subject to audit. The state auditor may inspect any state agency's books, papers, accounts, or  
18 records that may be relevant to an ongoing audit of any other state agency or computer system  
19 audit. The state auditor and persons employed by the state auditor examining any information,  
20 which is confidential by law, shall guard the secrecy of such information except when otherwise  
21 directed by judicial order or as is otherwise provided by law.
