- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15-10-37 and 15-10-38 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to eligibility for loans under the technology occupations student loan
- 3 program and eligibility for loan forgiveness under the teacher shortages loan forgiveness
- 4 program.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15-10-37 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 amended and reenacted as follows:

8	15-1	0-37. Technology occupations student loan program.
9	1.	The state board of higher education shall administer a technology occupations
10		student loan program that encourages college students to pursue
11		technology-based studies, to participate in technology internship programs, and to
12		remain in the state after graduation. The board shall adopt rules to implement the
13		program, including internship requirements, guidelines to determine which
14		technology-related courses of study are eligible under the program, and standards
15		for eligibility.
16	2.	Students Graduates of board-approved colleges may apply for the technology
17		occupations student loan program. To be eligible to receive student loan grants
18		under the program, the applicant:
19		a. Must have graduated from a board-approved college;
20		b. Must have successfully completed the board-approved technology-related
21		courses;
22		c. Must have maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average, based on a
23		4.0 grading system, at a board approved college;

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1		<del>d.</del>	Must have actively participated before graduation in a board-approved
2			technology internship with a business or governmental entity in the state;
3	e.	<u>d.</u>	Must have a student loan with the Bank of North Dakota or other participating
4			lender;
5	f <del>.</del>	<u>e.</u>	Following graduation must be employed in the state in a board-approved
6			technology occupation; and
7	<del>g.</del>	<u>f.</u>	Must have met and shall continue to meet any requirements established by
8			rule.
9	3.	The	state board of higher education shall distribute student loan grants directly to
10		the	Bank of North Dakota to repay outstanding student loan principal balances for
11		elig	ible applicants. The maximum student loan grant amount for which an
12		app	licant may qualify is one thousand dollars per twelve months of employment for
13		<del>a m</del>	aximum of five years year and a total of five thousand dollars, or a lesser
14		amo	ount established by rule adopted by the state board of higher education.

17			B. Loans - Teacher shortages - Loan forgiveness.
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1	5.	The board shall consider all applications under this section in chronological order.
2	6.	Upon notification that the individual has completed a full year of teaching in a
3		school district or nonpublic school in this state at a grade level or in a content area
4		identified by the superintendent of public instruction as one in which a teacher
5		shortage exists, the board shall distribute funds directly to the Bank of North
6		Dakota to repay outstanding loan principal balances for eligible applicants.
