- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 37-14-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to collecting fees on loans from the veterans' aid fund.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-14-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **37-14-07. Repayment to be made to aid fund.** Upon the granting of an application
- 7 and at the time of disbursement, the applicant, or the applicant's legally appointed guardian,
- 8 shall execute an agreement with the department of veterans' affairs that within a specified
- 9 period of not to exceed four years from the date of the receipt of the last item of the
- 10 advancement, the applicant will repay to the state for the use of the veterans' aid fund the full
- 11 amount of all advancements made to the applicant with interest as provided in rules adopted
- 12 under section 37-14-10, but not to exceed ten percent annually. One-half of the interest must
- 13 be waived if timely repayment is made to the fund. The department may take necessary legal
- 14 action to collect, compromise, or settle loans if in the opinion of the department the person has
- 15 the financial means to repay, and the person deliberately refuses to do so. The department
- 16 may release from financial liability any person it determines is financially unable to repay the
- 17 loan through no fault of the person. The department may assess and collect any reasonable
- 18 fees necessary to aid in the repayment of the loan.
