- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 5-01-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to definitions for the purpose of sale and consumption of alcoholic
- 3 beverages; and to amend and reenact sections 5-02-05 and 5-02-09 of the North Dakota
- 4 Century Code, relating to the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 5-01-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 "Twenty-one years of age" means it is after three a.m. on the date twenty-one
 9 years after a person's date of birth.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 5-02-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12 **5-02-05. Dispensing prohibited on certain days Penalty.** Any person who
- 13 dispenses or permits the consumption of alcoholic beverages on licensed premises after one
- 14 between two a.m. on Sundays, before and twelve noon on Sundays, or between the hours of
- 15 ene two a.m. and eight a.m. on all other days of the week, or who dispenses alcoholic
- 16 beverages or permits consumption of alcoholic beverages on licensed premises on Christmas
- 17 Day, after ene two a.m. on Thanksgiving Day, or after six p.m. on Christmas Eve is guilty of a
- 18 class A misdemeanor.
- 19 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 5-02-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 20 amended and reenacted as follows:
- **5-02-09. Local regulations.** The local governing body by ordinance or resolution may
- 22 regulate or restrict the operation of licensees including among other things determining the
- 23 number of licenses to be granted, establishing health and safety standards for licensed
- 24 premises, setting of hours and regulation of open door policies by fraternal organizations or

- 1 private clubs, <u>determining whether licensees may dispense or permit the consumption of</u>
- 2 <u>alcoholic beverages after one a.m. and until two a.m. subject to section 5-02-05,</u> and regulation
- 3 of dancing or various forms of entertainment on the premises.
