- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 53-06.2-11 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to transmissions of historic previously run horse and dog races;
- 3 and to amend and reenact subsection 11 of section 53-06.2-01 of the North Dakota Century
- 4 Code, relating to the definition of racing.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 11 of section 53-06.2-01 of the North Dakota
7 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 8 11. "Racing" means live or simulcast horse racing under the certificate system or 9 simulcast dog racing under the certificate system, including the transmission of
- 10 <u>historic previously run horse and dog races</u>.

11 SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 53-06.2-11 of the North Dakota Century

- 12 Code is created and enacted as follows:
- For each transmission of historic previously run horse and dog races in this state
   on win, place, and show parimutuel pools, the licensee shall deduct up to twenty
- 15 percent of the total win, place, and show pool. One-half of one percent must be
- 16 paid to the North Dakota racing commission to be used for the North Dakota purse
- 17 <u>fund, one-half of one percent must be paid to the North Dakota racing commission</u>
- 18 to be used for the North Dakota breeders' fund for the respective breed of horses
- 19 racing at that meet, one-half of one percent must be paid to the North Dakota
- 20 racing commission to be used for the racing promotion fund; and one percent must
- 21 <u>be paid to the state treasurer to be deposited in the general fund.</u>
