4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 5 of section 54-21.3-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 5. The governing body of a city, township, or county that elects to administer and enforce a building code shall adopt and enforce the state building code. However, the state building code may be amended by cities, townships, and counties to conform to local needs if the local standards meet or exceed those of the state building code.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-21.3-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 14 54-21.3-05. Enforcement of code by city, township, or county Relinquishment.
- 15 A Each city or township may shall administer and enforce the state building code enly within its
- 16 jurisdictional area. A county may shall administer and enforce the state building code within
- 17 those areas of the county in which the state building code is not administered by a city or
- 18 township. Cities and townships may relinquish their authority to administer and enforce the
- 19 state building code to the county in which they are located in the manner provided by section
- 20 11 33 20. The governing body of a each city, township, or and county electing to administer
- 21 and enforce the state building code may shall designate an a building code enforcement
- 22 agency. Cities, townships, and counties may, provide by agreement for joint administration and
- 23 enforcement and may, or contract for private enforcement of the state building code.
