1 A BILL for an Act to restrict the marketing of credit cards to students.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. Marketing of credit cards to students Restricted Policies. Each
 school district and each institution under the control of the state board of higher education shall
 prohibit the advertising, marketing, or merchandising of credit cards to students on school or
 institution property, except under an official school district or institution credit card marketing
 policy. An official school district or institution credit card marketing policy may include:
- 8 1. Registration of credit card marketers;
- 2. Limiting credit card marketers to specific dates and specific areas designated by
 the school or institution;
 - Prohibiting credit card marketers from offering a gift to a student in exchange for completing a credit card application; and
- Informing students about good credit management practices through programs
 such as workshops, seminars, discussion groups, and film presentations.
