- 1 A concurrent resolution for the amendment of section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of North
- 2 Dakota, relating to the definition of this state's militia; and to provide an effective date.

## 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 4 This measure defines reserve and active militia and removes obsolete language in regard to
- 5 age and gender in the reserve militia and removes residency requirements for membership in
- 6 the active militia that is defined as the National Guard of North Dakota.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF

## REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

- 9 That the following proposed amendment to section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of
- 10 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at
- 11 the primary election to be held in 2006, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 12 Constitution of North Dakota.

- 13 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 16 of article XI of the Constitution of North
- 14 Dakota is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **Section 16.** The reserve militia of this state shall consists of all able-bodied
- 16 male persons individuals eighteen years of age and older residing in the state, between the
- 17 ages of eighteen and forty five years, except such as may be unless exempted by the laws of
- 18 the United States or of this state. Persons The active militia is the national guard of this state
- 19 and consists of individuals who volunteer and are accepted unless exempted by the laws of the
- 20 United States or of this state. An individual whose religious tenets or conscientious scruples
- 21 forbid them that individual to bear arms shall may not be compelled to do so in times of peace,
- 22 but that individual shall pay an equivalent for a personal service.
- 23 **SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by the voters, this measure becomes
- 24 effective on August 1, 2006.
