- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 4-01-17.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the disposition of furs taken by the United States department of agriculture wildlife
- 3 services.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 4-01-17.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 **4-01-17.3.** Disposition of proceeds of furs, skins, and specimens taken. All furs,
- 8 skins, and specimens taken by hunters and trappers paid out of funds appropriated to carry out
- 9 section 4-01-17.1 must be disposed of in a manner the agriculture commissioner determines is
- 10 in the state's best interests. If furs, skins, or specimens are sold, the net proceeds of the sales,
- 11 up to fifteen thousand dollars per biennium, must be deposited with the state treasurer to be
- 12 <u>credited to the general fund</u> used by United States department of agriculture wildlife services to
- 13 fund its program activities that benefit the state's livestock producers.
