FIRST READING OF SENATE BILLS

Sen. Bowman and Rep. Porter introduced:

SB 2151: A BILL for an Act to create and enact two new sections to chapter 37-17.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to intrastate mutual aid by emergency response units; and to declare an emergency.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Government and Veterans Affairs Committee**.

Sens. Mathern, Nelson and Rep. Zaiser introduced:

SB 2152: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 57-02-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to property tax credits for persons sixty-five years of age or older or persons who are permanently and totally disabled; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sen. Wardner and Rep. N. Johnson introduced:

SB 2153: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-52.1-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to participation by political subdivision employees in the uniform group insurance program.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Political Subdivisions Committee**.

Sens. Heitkamp, Fischer, Lyson and Reps. Amerman, R. Kelsch, Nelson introduced:

SB 2154: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 24-02-01.5, 39-24-01, and 39-24-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to collector snowmobiles.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Transportation Committee**.

Sens. Heitkamp, Fischer, G. Lee and Reps. Belter, Delmore, Hawken introduced:

SB 2155: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-39-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to composition of the Lake Agassiz water authority.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

Sens. Klein, Erbele, Taylor and Reps. Brandenburg, Mueller, Pollert introduced:

SB 2156: A BILL for an Act to repeal section 4-24-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the collocation of agricultural promotion groups.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Sens. Wardner, Lindaas, Syverson and Reps. Drovdal, Headland introduced:

SB 2157: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-02-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to eligibility for and application of the homestead property tax credit; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Sens. Taylor, Espeland, Klein and Reps. Boe, Drovdal, N. Johnson introduced:

SB 2158: A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-35.3-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a financial institutions tax credit for contributions made for tuition scholarships to rural leadership North Dakota; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

The Senate stood adjourned pursuant to Senator Christmann's motion.
