This bill increases the fee for antlered deer hunting licenses from \$20 to \$35 and decreases the fee for antlereds deer licenses from \$20 to \$10.

The \$15 increase for the antlered deer licenses will produce about \$600,000 dollars in additional revenue per year. This uses 40,000 as the total number of licenses involved each year.

The reduction in price for the antlerless whitetailed deer licenses reduces revenue by \$800,000 per year based on 80,000 antlerless licenses per year.
